

The Propeller Club – Port Of Washington, DC Announces Jeff Vogel As New Vice President

WASHINGTON, D.C., April 29, 2019 — The Propeller Club – Port of Washington, DC, a chapter of the International Propeller Club of the United States, a nonprofit dedicated to the enhancement and well-being of all interests of the maritime community, named Cozen O'Connor attorney Jeff Vogel their new vice president.

He served as maritime legal adviser to the U.S. Trade Representative, and oversaw the legal aspects of the Capital Construction Fund and Construction Reserve Fund. Vogel earned degrees from the University of Maryland College Park, University of Miami Rosenstiel School of Marine and Atmospheric Science, the University of Miami School of Law, and the U.S. Naval War College.
