

3 Provisions to Watch in the FAA Reauthorization Bills

When asked about an amendment tacked on to the House's AIRR Act directing the Department of Transportation secretary to block foreign carries from flying to the U.S. if they don't adhere to certain labor standards or if they violate U.S. Open Skies agreements, Rob told *Law360*, "It's an additional requirement, and it'll certainly be a focus of future debate... As hot as the topic has been, the fact that was brought up and adopted nonchalantly, I would think that others are going to want to weigh in so we'll see."
